The Tuition Fee contributes funds towards the curriculum costs, staff salaries and other capital expenses.

The Resource Fee assists the funding of camps, retreats, excursions and other resources excluding those activities listed below where a levy is charged.

TECHNOLOGY LEVY

A technology levy of \$420 per annum, per family is charged to fund the technology budget including software licences. (The levy is not tax deductible).

INSTEP LEVY

A levy of \$350 will be charged for each student who participates in this program.

KAIROS LEVY

A levy of \$100 will be charged for each student who participates in this program.

BUILDING FUND

The Building Fund enables parents to make a direct contribution to the refurbishment, maintenance and development of buildings at the College. All families are asked to voluntarily donate to the Building Fund a gift of \$1,500 per family per year while their son/s attend the College. Payment is voluntary and donations are tax deductible.

FAMILY CONCESSIONS

There is a reduction of 15% in the tuition fees for the second son and 20% in the tuition fees for the third son attending the College at the same time. No tuition fees are charged for the fourth son. No concession applies to the eldest son in the College. [Contact should be made with the Bursar or Principal immediately if payment is causing financial hardship.](#)

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC TUITION

Secondary and Junior School students undertaking instrumental music tuition will be charged:-

- \$1,250 per annum for lessons of 40 minute duration
- \$940 per annum for lessons of 30 minute duration
- \$470 per annum for Pipes and Drums instruction
- Junior School students sharing lessons of 30 minute duration will be charged \$470 per annum.
- Percussion students will pay a \$240 per annum equipment maintenance fee
- Pipes and Drums students will pay a \$240 per annum equipment maintenance fee.

- Musical Instruments are available for hire at a charge of \$240 per annum.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

For 2009 you will have a choice of three payment options.

1. Payment of the Account in full by 20 February 2009.
2. Payment by three instalments due on 20 February, 29 May and 21 August 2009.
3. Payment by ten monthly or twenty fortnightly instalments.

Your completed Payment Option form is to be returned to the Bursar by Friday 13 February 2009.

PAYMENT METHODS



Paying By Online Store

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1, 2 & 3.

Go to www.trinity.wa.edu.au and select Community then click on Online Store.

Select fees then enter your reference. Your reference is shown on the tear off remittance advice of your Fee Statement. It is the line above the name & address and is usually the father's surname and first initial. Next, enter the amount to pay and then follow the prompts.

Please complete the **white** Online Store Payment Advice and return to the Bursar by 13 February.



Paying By BPAY (Biller code 53074)

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1, 2 & 3.

Telephone and Internet banking. Call your bank, credit union or building society to make this payment from your cheque, savings or credit card account. Refer to your fee statement for your reference number.

Please complete the **pink** BPAY Payment Advice and return to the Bursar by 13 February.



Paying By Direct Debit

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1, 2 & 3.

This allows your account to be paid automatically to the College from a nominated bank or credit card account. American Express and Diners Club cards are not accepted. There is a schedule showing the processing dates for each of the six templates.

Please complete the **yellow** form for payment by **credit card** and return to the Bursar by 13 February.

Please complete the **green** form for payment from **cheque/savings account** and return to the Bursar by 13 February.



Mailing your Payment

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1 and 2 only.

Tear off the remittance advice and send your cheque or credit card details to Trinity College, Accounts Department, Trinity Avenue, East Perth WA 6004.



Pay By Phone

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1 and 2 only.

Telephone the College Office on 9223 8168, ask for Fees Payable and have your credit card details available. American Express and Diners Club cards are not accepted.

Paying in Person

This method of payment is available for Payment Options 1 and 2 only.

Present the remittance advice with your payment to the College Office during office hours (8.00am to 4.30pm). Various debit and credit cards are accepted. American Express and Diners Club are not accepted.

TAX DEDUCTIBLE DONATIONS

The Trinity College Community has in the past made a strong commitment to donating funds to capital projects. Tax Deductible donations can be made to the following funds:-

Scholarship and Bursary Fund - to assist those boys who would not normally be able to attend the College for financial reasons.

Library Fund - to contribute monies or gifts to support the ongoing development of the College Library.

Building Fund - to assist the ongoing maintenance and capital improvement of the College.

APPLICATION FEE

In order to register a student for enrolment, an Application for Admission form must be completed and an administration fee of \$132 (inclusive of GST) paid. This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee enrolment.

ENROLMENT FEE

Prior to the date of entry, parents to whom a place may be offered will be asked to arrange an interview with the Head of School. A non-refundable enrolment fee of \$1,200 is payable once an offer is made.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

One term's notice in writing must be given prior to the removal of a pupil, otherwise a full term's fee will be charged.

SCHOOL BOOKS & SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Book sales are conducted by Supply West Bookland (Secondary School) and Wooldridges (Junior School). Booklists and further details are provided at the time.

INSURANCE

The College has a Student Accident Insurance Policy covering all students 24 hours per day for lump sum benefits for **non Medicare** claimable items. The College does not accept responsibility for any claim to property loss or damage incurred by students or parents.

STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The WA Department of Education funds a High School clothing allowance and Secondary Assistance Scheme for parents holding a Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card, Health Care

Card, or a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card only). To be eligible students must be full time, secondary and born on or after 1 January 1991. Please contact the Bursar for further details.
